Congress passed the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) over three decades ago "to ensure that all children with disabilities have available to them a free appropriate public education . . . designed to meet their unique needs and prepare them for further education, employment, and independent living." While many students with disabilities receive good educations, far too many receive educations that are weak and inadequate. Parents — whom Congress envisioned as equal partners in developing their children's educational programs — face a playing field that is neither level nor fair. COPAA is committed to creating a level playing field, and to ensuring that children with disabilities receive the same high-quality education as all children.
